
Background

- ABA commissioned QCIFY to consolidate QC data across all the businesses for the period spanning 2022-2024.
- Data has been aggregated and anonymous.
- One of the objectives was to identify whether there was evidence to support the view across industry that NP quality has been declining in recent seasons.
- It is high level, not possible to split data between regions.
- Data consists of 110,404 samples, 7 locations, 18 machines over the three-year period.
- QCIFY application declined in 2024 and therefore number of samples taken using this equipment reduced considerably from 2023 to 2024 (may influence results).









Variety Split



















Specific defects by variety




